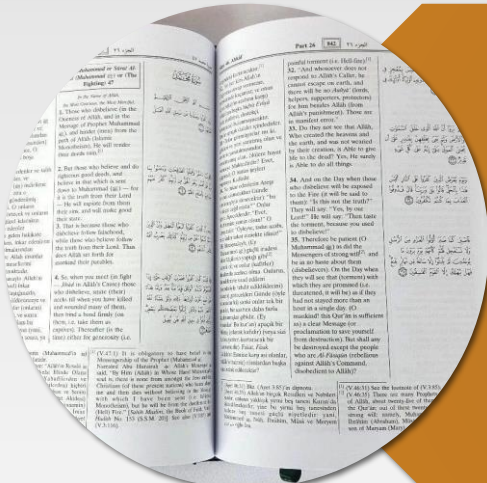

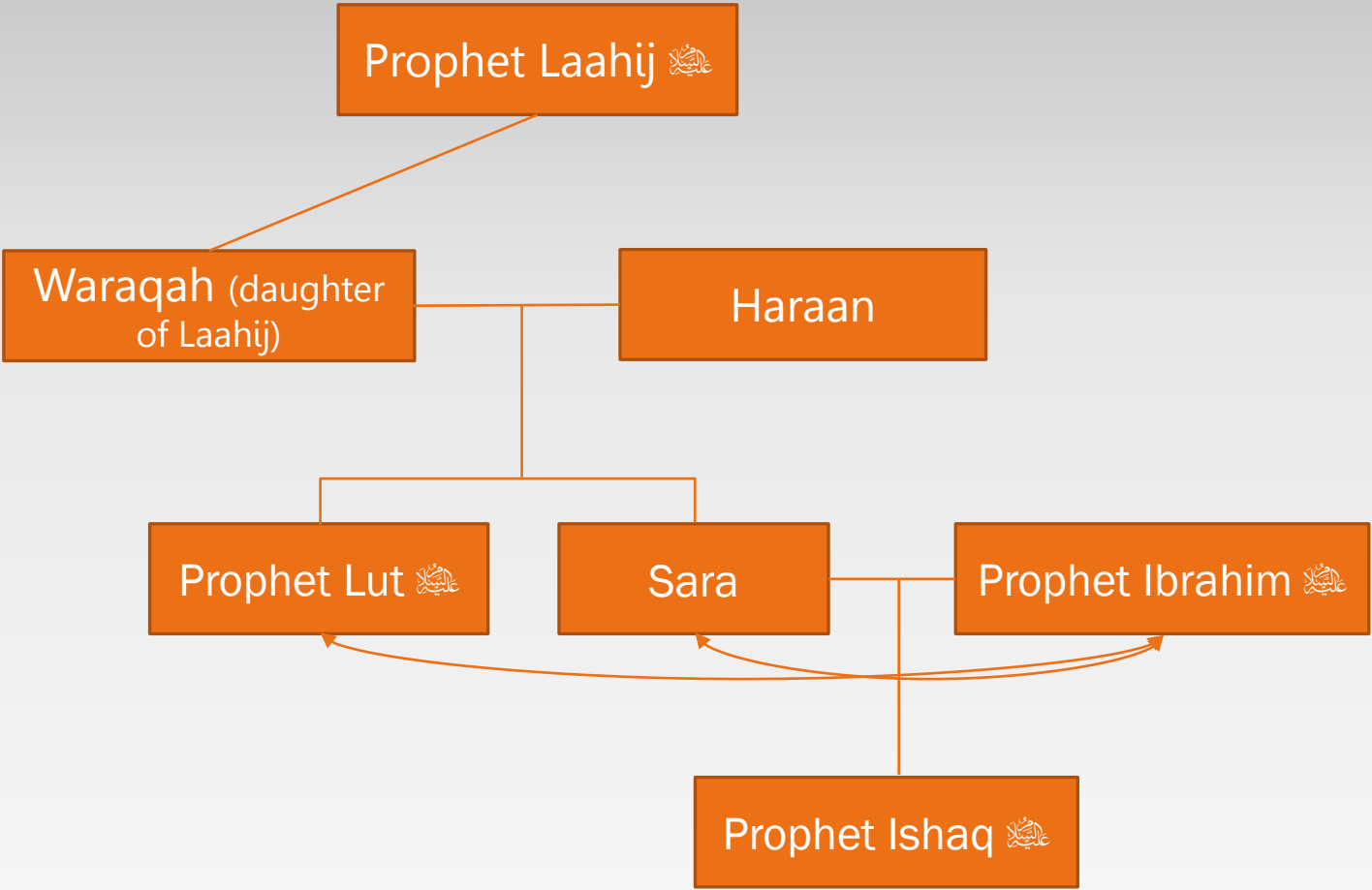
Sūrat Al-‘Ankabūt: Verses 26 to 27

فَأَمَّنَ لَهُ لُوطٌ وَقَالَ إِنِّي مُهَاجِرٌ إِلَىٰ رَبِّي إِنَّهُ هُوَ الْعَزِيزُ
الْحَكِيمُ ﴿٢٦﴾

And *Prophet Lut* became a believer *in the message of Prophet Ibrahim* because of him – *because of the propagation of Prophet Ibrahim*, and then *Prophet Ibrahim* after having been thrown into the fire and persecuted said, "I shall migrate where I have been commanded to by my Lord. Indeed He is the All-Mighty, the All-Wise." (26)

الدُّنْيَا وَإِنَّهُ فِي الْآخِرَةِ لَمِنَ الصَّالِحِينَ ﴿٢٧﴾

And We bestowed on him, *Ibrahim, righteous offspring such as Ishaq, his son, and Ya'qub, his grandson, and We perpetuated the gift of prophethood and the Scripture in his descendants. And We gave him his reward in this life and he will most surely occupy an eminent place among the righteous in the Hereafter. (27)*

Sūrat Al-‘Ankabūt: Verses 26 to 27

Points for Reflection

1. It is possible for there to be more than one prophet at one time in one region, however only ONE has authority (in this case, Ibrahim ؑ and Lut ؑ were together at the same time, but Ibrahim ؑ was the Ulul Azm prophet and leader and Lut ؑ was his follower)
2. It is possible to combine having the “goodness” in this world and also having “goodness” in the next world.
